
15D14N INDONESIA: CULTURAL AND ANIMAL WORLDS FROM JAVA VIA BORNEO TO BALI

Destinations : Bali and Lombok.

Durations : 14 nights/15 days

Valid until : December 2022

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN JAKARTA - CHECK IN HOTEL

Selamatdatang! Welcome to Jakarta. Upon arrival at the international airport, you will be picked up by our driver and transferred to the airport hotel in Jakarta. Relax and prepare for the next few days in the jungle. Depending on your arrival time, you can optionally explore the metropolis of Jakarta with your driver on a small city tour.

Note: A direct onward flight from Jakarta to Kalimantan is not possible on the same day.

DAY 2: FLIGHT TO PANGKALANBUN, AIRPORT - KUMAI HARBOR - HOUSEBOAT - PROBOSCIS TOUR (B, L, D)

After breakfast we will take you to the airport for your flight to Pangkalanbun on Borneo.

Trigana Air IL-708 Departure Jakarta CGK 09:25 Arrival Pangkalanbun PKN 10:50

Economy Class: approx. € 65 per person (luggage: 20 kg)

Upon your arrival in Pangkalan Bun Airport, meeting service with our staff and guide then direct transfer to Kumai. It will take about 20 minutes. Upon your arrival in Kumai direct transfer to the houseboat, Lunch will be provided On board. Afterward boating down Kumai River takes approximately 15 minutes to reach Sekonyer River, the main river in Tanjung Puting National Park. Cruising up the Sekonyer River you will see nice vegetation around the river bank, Nipa Palm, Pandanus, and some kinds of trees that grow around the river. See some wildlife such as birds, Macaque, Proboscis Monkey and Orangutan, if the time still permits you will visit Orangutan feeding in Tanjung Harapan at 15.00 PM. Then At 16.00 return back to the boat and continue boating up to observe and learn more about Proboscis monkeys along the river banks. Proboscis monkeys are endemic animals that can be seen only in Borneo. Dinner and Overnight in a Houseboat.

Accommodation:**Standard: Klotok House Boat****DAY 3: PASALAT CAMP - CAMP LEAKEY (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, proceed up the river to Pasalat Camp, here you will be hiking up on the boardwalk for 800 Meters and 200 meters you will walk on the ground. In this camp you will have a chance to plant endemic fruit trees for orangutans and this is also the carbon offset program. This program supports the national park by replanting the trees around the ex-forest fire areas and to spread up the fruit trees for the animals in this park. When the tree grows up, the trees will do photosynthesis. From this process the tree will produce the Oxygen, and the Oxygen is the payment to all the Carbon we produce in our whole life (payment of the carbon). Return back to the houseboat then boating up directly to Camp Leakey. Lunch will be provided on board. On arrival in Camp Leakey, you

Will visit IC (Information Center) to see all the work of DR. Birute Galdikas studied the orangutan here from 1971 until today. Enjoy your time until 14.00, afterward continue trekking up into the forest to see orangutan feeding, enjoy the time till 16.00 back to the boat then boating down to Pondok Ambung. If the time permitted before dinner you will trekking into the forest for 2 hours to see the nocturnal animals like Tarsiers, tarantulas, etc. back to the houseboat. Dinner and overnight in the houseboat.

Accommodation:**Standard: Klotok House Boat****DAY 4: PONDOK TANGGUI - TANJUNG HARAPAN VILLAGE - TANJUNG HARAPAN CAMP (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, boating down to reach Pondok Tanggui, the second rehabilitation center for the orangutan. Visit the Orangutan feeding 09.00 AM, enjoy your time while taking some pictures. Then at 10.00 AM return back to the houseboat and continue boating down direct to Tanjung Harapan village to see the Malayan settlement activities in the Afternoon. Lunch will be provided on board then cross to Tanjung Harapan Camp to see the last orangutan feeding at 15.00 you will stay until 16.00 pm. Back to the boat and boating down directly to the Nipa Palm area to see thousands of fireflies. Dinner and overnight in the houseboat.

DAY 5: FLIGHT TO SEMARANG - TRANSFER TO BOROBUDUR (B)

After breakfast , your driver will take you from the boat to the airport, from where your journey continues to the island of Java.

Trigana Air IL-701 Departure Pangkalanbun 11:30 Arrival Semarang 12:35

Economy Class: approx. € 55 Per Person (luggage: 20 kg)

Upon arrival in Semarang, you'll be picked up from the airport and driven to your hotel in Borobudur, north of Yogyakarta, where you'll spend the afternoon relaxing. The drive from the airport to Borobudur takes about 2.5 hours and offers you a great view of the volcanoes of Central Java.

DAY 6: SUNRISE AND BIKE TOUR IN KULONPROGO (B, L)

In the early morning hours you would be picked up by our driver to experience the sunrise over Borobudur Temple. After sunrise you will have enough time to explore the temple complex of Borobudur before the temple opens to other tourists.

The Buddhist temple Borobudur was built in the 8th century and was buried with ashes by a volcanic eruption in 1006. It was not until 1814 that Borobudur was rediscovered and extensively restored between 1973 and 1984 to restore the complex to its former glory.

After your temple visit, travel with your driver to the south of Yogyakarta towards Kulon Progo. The drive to the village of Sentolo takes about 1 – 1.5 hours. From here you can cycle through the surrounding villages and rice fields. In Sentolo, you'll learn about tempeh (fermented soybeans) making, traditional weaving, and everyday life in a Javanese village. Finally, enjoy a traditional Indonesian lunch.

DAY 7: FROM BOROBUDUR TO YOGYAKARTA (B)



After breakfast and checkout, your driver will pick you up for a small city tour of Yogyakarta. First, your driver will take you to Beringharjo Market. In addition to food, clothing, jewelry, and kitchen accessories are also offered. Hagggle with the vendors for the best price, taste exotic fruits or buy yourself a nice batik cloth. From Beringharjo Market, continue to Tamansari Water Castle. Afterwards we continued to Kampung Tirtodipuran. Kampung Tirtodipuran is the center for batik, a traditional Indonesian textile dyeing process in which the pattern is covered with liquid wax, which retains the original color of the fabric on subsequent dyeing. Afterwards we accompany you on a tour of Kota Gede, the then capital of the Mataram Kingdom which was once the economic and cultural center of the kingdom. In the afternoon we go to the hotel in Yogyakarta.

DAY 8: PRAMBANAN - RATU BOKO TEMPLE (B)



Breakfast in the hotel. In the morning, the whole day is at your leisure.

In the afternoon, travel with your driver to Prambanan Temple, one of the largest Hindu temples in Southeast Asia, recognized as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1991. This Hindu temple complex was built between the 8th and 10th centuries, and consists of eight main shrines and more than 250 individual temples. Afterwards we go to the Ratu Boko Temple for a great sunset. After your temple visit, your driver will take you back to the hotel.

Accommodation:**Yogyakarta - Jogja Village Inn 3* (Deluxe Room)****DAY 9: FROM YOGYAKARTA TO BROMO (B)**

After breakfast and check out, our driver will take you to your hotel near Mount Bromo. The journey there takes about 7-8 hours. In the afternoon, you can stay uninterrupted at your hotel.

Accommodation:**Bromo Terrace, Bromo 3. 5* (Deluxe Room)****DAY 10: BROMO VOLCANO – TRANSFER TO BANYUWANGI (B)**

Early in the morning you will drive by jeep to Bromo Crater, where you will climb an approximately 250 steps up to the crater rim guided by your flashlight. From the crater and des Bromos you can enjoy the sunrise and then explore the surroundings of the volcano. On the way back to the hotel, you will stop at a viewpoint from where you will have a fantastic view of the two volcanoes Bromo and Semeru. Afterwards you will return to your hotel for breakfast before continuing by car towards Ijen. The drive to Banyuwangi in East Bali takes about 7 hours and takes you past numerous tobacco, cocoa and coffee plantations. You can stop along the way at any time if you see something interesting on the side of the road.

Hint:

Normally you visit the viewpoint for the sunrise, from which you can see the Bromo and Semeru and only then drive by jeep to the volcano itself. Meanwhile, more than 1000 jeeps drive to these viewpoints every morning and it is very crowded. After sunrise, all jeeps drive to the volcano itself, which often leads to traffic jams. Therefore, we recommend making it upside down. First the Bromo itself (where there will not be so many tourists right after sunrise) and then to a viewpoint for a great view over the volcano.

DAY 11: EXPLORING THE IJEN VOLCANO – PEMUTERAN (B)



Early in the morning, your driver will pick you up at the hotel and take you to the Ijen volcano. On a 1.5-hour hike to the crater rim of the Ijen, you will enjoy spectacular views of the surrounding area of the Ijen volcano. From the edge of the sulphurous crater lake, you can watch the workers mining sulfur by hand surrounded by plumes of smoke. After this experience, head back to your hotel for breakfast. In the afternoon we continue to Ketapang Port, from here we take the ferry to Bali and with your driver on to Pemuteran.

Optional: Start at midnight for the "blue flames" in Ijen Crater.

Adi Assri Resort & Spa, Pemuteran 3.5* (Deluxe Garden View)

DAY 12: SNORKELING TRIP TO MENJANGAN ISLAND (B, L)



After breakfast we go to the beach of Banyuwedang today. A brisk boat trip away is the island of Menjangan, where you will discover the fascinating underwater world of the West Bali National Park while snorkeling. In addition to angelfish, clownfish and large swarms of chromis, you may also see a ray with a little luck. At noon you will receive a small packed lunch before returning to the hotel by boat and car.

Accommodation:

Adi Assri Resort & Spa, Pemuteran 3.5* (Deluxe Garden View)

DAY 13: FROM PEMUTERAN TO SANUR (B)

Breakfast at the hotel. After breakfast and checkout, your driver will take you to Sanur. On the way we first head towards the Banyumala waterfall. The walk from the parking lot takes about 20 minutes. Once you arrive at the waterfall, you can enjoy the beautiful nature or cool off in the fresh mountain water. Your next destination is the Jatiluwih rice terraces. The UNESCO World Heritage Site is a kind of tangible museum that shows the traditional agriculture of Bali. Through smart land use and traditional irrigation systems, local farmers have created picture-perfect rice terraces in the steep slopes. Then, visit Taman Ayun Royal Temple, one of the most beautiful and impressive temples in Bali, known for its multi-story rooftops. After the temple visit, your driver will take you to your Hotel in Sanur.

Accommodation:**Artotel Sanur 3* (Studio 30)****DAY 14: FREEDAY IN SANUR (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Afterwards, the whole day is at your leisure. Relax by the hotel pool or explore the beaches in front of your hotel on foot. On the beach of Sanur there are many possibilities to test different water sports e.g. kite surfing, surfing, canoeing or windsurfing. On the beach promenade there are many delicious restaurants with international cuisine, where you can enjoy a romantic dinner overlooking the sea.

Accommodation:**Artotel Sanur 3* (Studio 30)****DAY 15: DEPARTURE (B)**

Enjoy your last day in Bali. After check-out, transfer will be made to Denpasar Airport for your flight home. We wish you a good return flight!
